# DAY 1 - WED SEPT 30: USA | EUROPE

Depart USA for your flight to Cairo with overnight on board.

## DAY 2 - THU OCT 1: CAIRO

Arrive at Cairo's International Airport where you will be met and assisted through customs an passport control formalities. Enjoy your panoramic drive through Cairo before checking in to your hotel for overnight.

## DAY 3 - FRI OCT 2: ASWAN | CRUISE SHIP

After an early breakfast, we begin our tour of fabulous Egypt (Africa.) We will be transferred to the airport for our flight to Aswan, the Pearl of the Nile. We arrive in Aswan and on our way to the cruise ship, we will stop by the High Dam—the pride of modern Egypt. The unfinished obelisk will be our next stop where we will see how the ancient Egyptians made such a huge stone stand on one edge. We will have lunch on board the cruise ship and then cross by ferry boat to the Isis Island where we will see the Phaile temple that was saved from thje rising waters of the Nile. Back to the ship for dinner and overnight.

# DAY 4 - SAT OCT 3: CRUISE SHIP

Today, we sail to the temple of Kom Umbo, shared by the

two gods Sobek and Haroeris. Returning to our ship, we relax until after lunch. We then disembark and ride in a horse drawn cart to visit one of the best kept and preserved temples in Egypt—the temple of Edfu, dedicated to the god Horus. This visit will take about two hours while we see intact stones and colors that will leave memories never to be forgotten. Returning to our ship, we sail for Luxor. Sunset, tea and fresh breezes await you tonight before the Galabyia part where we will see some Egyptian folklore shows with Nubian shows. Dinner and overnight.



#### DAY 5 - SUN OCT 4: CRUISE SHIP

While we sail to Luxor we enjoy the scenery along the sugar cane fields. Arrival in Luxor – appearing as an open museum which takes you back to a beautiful era of solemnity and productivity. Visit the Temple of Luxor and Karnack Temple, surrounded by the Sacred Lake. Qebash Avenue is the road which leads us to the holy of holiest. Dinner and overnight aboard ship.

## DAY 6 - MON OCT 5: CRUISE | CAIRO

After breakfast we will cross by ferry to the West Bank (city of the dead) to vist the Deir el Bahari Temple dedicated to Hatshepsut, the first female ruler in the history of mankind. Continue to the Valley of Kings – the most famous site all over the world with its colors and carvings intact. On the way to the airport, we will stop at the two Colossi of Memnon. Then fly back to Cairo for dinner and overnight at our hotel.

# DAY 7 - TUE OCT 6: CAIRO | GIZA | SAKKARA | CAIRO

After breakfast we will start our first touring day in Egypt. Our first stop will be at the Pyramids of Giza. Cheops Pyramid, the largest of the three, was built in the 3rd dynasty about 2690 B.C. and is one of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World. In front of the Pyramids of Chephren, we will find the colossal statue of the Great Sphinx, which has stood guard over the pyramids for more than 4,500 years. During our Pyramids visit you will have a chance to ride a camel near the pyramids (optional). This afternoon we drive to Sakkara's step pyramids, the oldest in existence and the world's first stone tombs. Visit the Step Pyramid of Zoser I, dating from 2,686 B.C. and the oldest in the world. Visit the Tomb of Ptah-hotep, author of the oldest surviving book in the world, circa 2350 BC. Return to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

# DAY 8 - WED OCT 7: CAIRO

This morning we drive in to Coptic Cairo, where we will visit the most famous site, the Church of the Virgin Mary, better known by its nickname, the Hanging

Church, This name comes from the fact that it was built atop the walls of the 4th century BC Roman fortress of Babylon, the remains of which are still visible about Coptic Cairo. We will continue to the Church of St. Sergius, a 5th century Coptic Church dedicated to two Martyrs (Sergius and Bacchus) traditionally believed to have been built on the spot where the Holy Family rested at the end of their journey into Egypt. As we stroll along, we will come to the recently restored Synagogue of Ben Ezra, which marks the place where Moses was saved by the water girl of the Pharaoh. This afternoon we proceed to the Egyptian museum, home to 120,000 Egyptian artifacts, although it should be noted that not all items are on display. Some passengers may want to spend their time here while the rest can visit the Grand Bazaar for shopping of all types of Egyptian souvenirs. At the museum there is an entire section within the museum which has been dedicated to the boy king, Tutankhamen. He is after all the most famous of all the Egyptian pharaohs. This area features the famous Tutankhamun collection with its beautiful gold death mask and sarcophagus and the royal Mummy room, which houses an additional eleven Pharaonic dignitaries. Dinner and overnight at our hotel this evening.

# DAY 9 - THU OCT 8: CAIRO | AIRPORT

Today is a day at leisure for activities of your own in the Giza area around the pyramids and the Sphinx. This evening we drive into Cairo to enjoy a farewell dinner on the Nile. Continue to the airport for our return flight home.

# DAY 10 - FRI OCT 9: NORTH AMERICA

Arrival in the USA and continue home - the close of our unforgettable journey.
