

Day 1 - MON APR 27: USA / ISRAEL. Tour members will gather at the ticket counter at the airport two hours prior to the departure to Europe. Dinner and breakfast will be served in flight.

Day 2 - TUE APR 28: TEL AVIV / TIBERIAS. Upon our arrival at the Tel Aviv airport we will be met and board our motor coach to begin the thrilling journey of following in the footsteps of Jesus. We drive to Caesarea by the sea where we'll visit the Crusader's Castle, the Roman Amphitheater and waterduct, and the port from which the Apostle Paul sailed to Rome. We will continue northward along the Mediterranean coast to Mount Carmel where Elijah defeated the prophets of Baal by the Brook Kishon. Continue to Megiddo, Armageddon, a very important strategic point on the Via Maris connecting Egypt and Damascus. It is the city which has witnessed many wars and suffered many destruction throughout the different periods of time. Then to Tiberias and our hotel on the beautiful Sea of Galilee for dinner and overnight.

Day 3 - WED APR 29: TIBERIAS / THE SEA OF GALILEE / CAPERNAUM / MOUNT OF BEATITUDES / TABGHA / CAESAREA PHILIPPI / MT. HERMON / GOLAN HEIGHTS / THE JORDAN RIVER.

This day will be an exciting day in the Galilee area. After a delicious breakfast we will depart from the Roman hot springs resort city of Tiberias via a boat ride across the Sea of Galilee to Capernaum (John 6:24) to visit the ancient ruins of this first century synagogue where Jesus preached (Matthew 4:13-17). Then on to the Mt. of Beatitudes where Jesus preached the Sermon on the Mount (Matthew 5-7), and to Tabgha, the chapel dedicated to the multiplication of the loaves and fishes (Mark 6:34-44). We will then proceed to Upper Galilee and the site of Peter's Confession (Matthew 16:16) at Caesarea Philippi and to Mt. Hermon (Psalm 89:12), the probable site of the Transfiguration (Matthew 17:1-8) and the present day Golan Heights where Israel, Lebanon and Syria come together. Return via Safed and Chorazin and to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

Day 4 - THU APR 30: MT. TABOR / DEBORIYA / NAIN / BEIT SHEAN / TIBERIAS. Leave Tiberias and drive to Cana where the first miracle took place, the Transformation of Water into Wine. Continue to Nazareth, tracing the early life of the Holy Family. Visit the replica of the Nazareth Village. View Mary's Well. We continue to Beitshean. Optional Baptisms at the Yardenit Baptist site on the Jordan River and then back to Tiberias for some time at leisure before dinner and overnight.

Day 5 - FRI MAY 1: TIBERIAS / AMMAN / MT. NEBO / DEAD SEA

Today we depart Tiberias and drive to the Sheik Hussein Bridge and cross into Jordan. Continue to Amman to visit the Citadel. Towering above Amman, the site of the earliest fortifications is now subject to numerous excavations which have revealed `remains of fortifications from the Middle Bronze Age (2nd mill. B.C.) and the Iron Age (8th century B.C.), as well as from Hellenistic (2nd century B.C.) and the late Roman to Arab Islamic Ages'. Continue to Mount Nebo commemorating the site where Moses saw the Promised Land and died. Then we travel to the Dead Sea for some time at leisure before dinner at our hotel. Perhaps take a dip or and optional Spa.

Day 6 - SAT MAY 2: DEAD SEA / PETRA.

This morning we meet early (7:00 AM) to visit the Dead Sea store for shopping. Then we continue to Petra, "The Rose Red City - Half as Old as Time". This ancient Edomite and Nabatean capital is an amazing city of prophecy with its famed gorge, ancient street, temples, dwelling places and tombs carved from the solid rock. Arrive at El Ji Post and continue the one-mile journey passing through the famous SIQ (natural gorge) and arrive at the "Treasury". (Some horse carts are available for rent) Visit the ancient theater. In the Nabatean Judgment Hall, Place Tombs, famous Urn Temple and the Roman amphitheater. Those willing to climb may view the monastery, Jebel Harun (Mountain of Aaron), supposed to be the burial place of Aaron. Horseback journey back to El Ji Post. Dinner and overnight at our hotel.

Day 7 - SUN MAY 3: PETRA / EILAT.

This morning we drive to Wadi Rum for a day trip to marvel at the gravity-defying geological formations that abound throughout the region, from the legendary Seven Pillars of Wisdom, to the great Umm Fruth Rock Bridge and the Khaz'ali Canyon, complete with its wealth of ancient Nabataean cave paintings. Continue south to the Israeli border and our hotel in Eilat for dinner and overnight.

Day 8 - MON MAY 4: EILAT - TABERNACLE - MASADA - JERUSALEM.

This morning, we continue to Timna Park, 20 miles north of Eilat in the Arabah, where a life-size replica of the biblical tabernacle has been constructed. The model is accurate in every way, based upon the biblical description. We drive to Masada, a truly remarkable piece of history. We ascend Masada by cable car to walk among the magnificent ruins of the fortress where, from 70-73 A.D., the Jewish defenders made the last stand of the Judean Revolt against Rome and where the remains of storehouses, cisterns and a sixth century Byzantine church are still on view. Continue on to our Jerusalem hotel for dinner and overnight in "the Holy City".

Day 9 - TUE MAY 5: MOUNTAINS OF JERUSALEM AND BETHLEHEM.

Drive to the Mount of Olives with its outstanding

view of the city. Visit the Chapel of Ascension, Church of Pater Noster, Garden of Gethsemane, Church of All Nations. View the Kidron Valley. Drive to Bethlehem for a visit to the Church of the Nativity, visit the Shepherd's Fields and the Fields of Boaz and Ruth. An afternoon drive to visit Mount Zion, the site where Jesus accomplished His Ministry. Visit the room of the Last Supper. Visit the Tomb of King David and the House of Caiaphas; proceed to the Knesset, or the House of Parliament. Visit the Shrine of the Book enclosing the Scrolls of the Dead Sea. Visit the model of Jerusalem as it was layed out during the time of Christ. Return to your hotel for dinner and overnight.

Day 10 - WED MAY 6: THE WILDERNESS OF JUDEA.

Depart Jerusalem this morning and drive into the Judean Desert. Visit Bethany and Lazarus' Tomb and the Inn of the Good Samaritan. Continue to Jericho, the cradle of Civilization. Visit the ruins of Tel El Sultan, ruins of one of the oldest cities in the world; view the Mount of Temptation where Satan tempted Jesus when he fasted for forty days. Visit Elisha's Spring. Return to Jerusalem for some leisure time for shopping and then we return to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

Day 11 - THU MAY 7: JERUSALEM, THE HOLY CITY.

This morning we proceed towards the city walls built by Solomon the Magnificent enclosing the most Holy sites. Walk into the old city through Damascus Gate and through the picturesque colorful bazaars to the superb Temple Area, where Solomon's Temple was built on Mount Moriah. Visit the Dome of the Rock enclosing the Rock of Sacrifice; the Mosque of Al Aska, further south, the Pinnacle of the Temple and the Western Wall or the Wailing Wall. In the afternoon, start at Saint Stephen's Gate and back into the Old City to visit the Church of Saint Anne, the Pool of Bethesda, the Lithostrotos, Pilate's Judgement Hall and walk on the Via Dolorosa leading us to the Church of the Holy Sepulchre. Visit the Garden Tomb and Gordon's Calvary, the site where Jesus was crucified, buried and resurrected. A service can be arranged at the Garden Tomb. Then, on to a local restaurant for our Farewell Dinner. Continue to the airport for our late evening flight to the U.S.

Day 12 - FRI MAY 8: ARRIVE USA.

Arrive early in the morning and continue home - the end of a most enjoyable journey
